

Route description UZ Leuven – Herestraat 49 – 3000 Leuven

Short directions:

- On the E314, take exit Gasthuisberg (16) and follow the road signs to the main entrance of the hospital.
- Through our main entrance you will reach the reception, please take the stairs and follow the bordeaux arrows until you reach the elevators. Go to the 7th floor (Laboratory medicine).
- On weekdays between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. you can walk through our glass door. On your right you will find our sample reception, where you can register the sample.
On weekend days / night our glass door is closed. You have to use the phone on the left side of the glass door to call the permanent number indicated next to the phone. An employee will open the door for you and collect your sample.

Note: when sending samples, please follow directive UN 3373. Please present the application form separate from the triple-wrapped samples.

To pack the 2019 n-CoV samples, the sample should be:

- 1) in an UTM tube, in
- 2) a plastic hermetically resealable bag with an absorbent paper, in
- 3) a padded envelope or a second plastic hermetically resealable bag.


Detailed directions:

Motorway (E40-E314)

Coming from the motorway take the E314 exit Gasthuisberg (16).

After leaving the motorway, follow the access road to Campus Gasthuisberg.

Stay in the right lane and take the second exit (emergencies) at the roundabout. Follow the road signs until you reach the main entrance/reception hall of the hospital.



Main entrance: reception Campus Gasthuisberg

At the reception, take the stairs and follow the bordeaux arrow. Continue straight ahead.



At the point below, turn left and keep following the bordeaux arrows.




At the next point, turn right and follow the bordeaux arrows.



At the glass wall, turn right and walk straight ahead for a while until you appear at the elevators.



At the elevators, enter number 7 and wait until the screen indicates which elevator to take.



Once you arrive at the 7th floor, you will see a glass door. On weekdays, our door is always open from 8 a.m. until 7 p.m. During the weekend and at night this door will be closed.



If the door is closed, you have to use the phone on the left side of the glass door to call the permanent number indicated next to the phone. An employee will open the door for you and accept your sample.



If the door is open, you can find our sample reception on the right. Our employees will collect your sample here.
